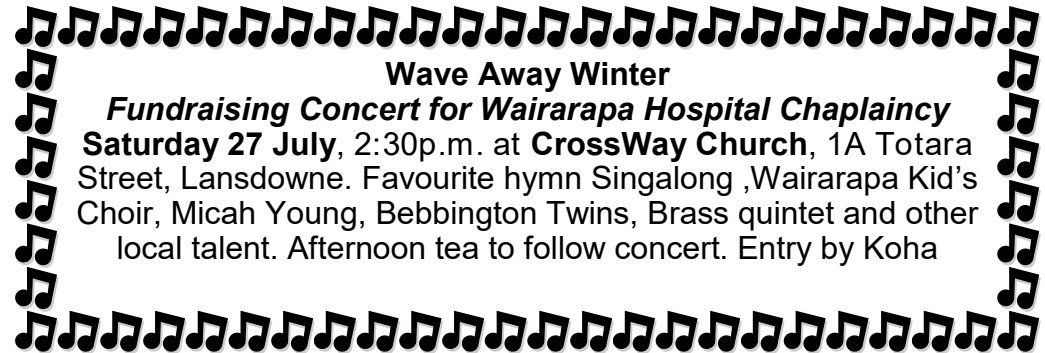
## School Holiday Activities
